## Quotes in the text

- Paraphrase → (Author, Year)
  - o Gender is a social construction (Butler, 1990).
  - Butler (1990) argues that gender is socially constructed.
  - Several studies confirm that masculinity is shaped by cultural norms (Connell, 2005; Kimmel, 2018).
- <u>Direct quote</u> → (Author, Anno, p. XX)
  - o "Gender is not something we are, but something we do" (Butler, 1990, p. 25).
  - Butler (1990) states that "gender is not something we are, but something we do" (p. 25).
